

## Hospital Services

Located on the fifth floor of Saint Luke's Hospital are our medical/oncology unit and separate Blood and Marrow Transplant Unit. We provide a variety of oncology services, including chemotherapy, blood product administration, antibiotic therapy, radiation implant therapy, pain control, and post-surgical/post-special procedures care, and manage additional therapies that require hospitalization. We also care for Blood and Marrow Transplant Program patients who require hospitalization.

## Nutritional Care

Our registered dietitian is experienced in working with cancer patients and their concerns about good nutrition. The dietitian will furnish you with written materials on caloric intake, supplements, and any special diets that are prescribed. The dietitian also makes suggestions about food recipes that are both tasty and nutritious.

## Family Accommodations

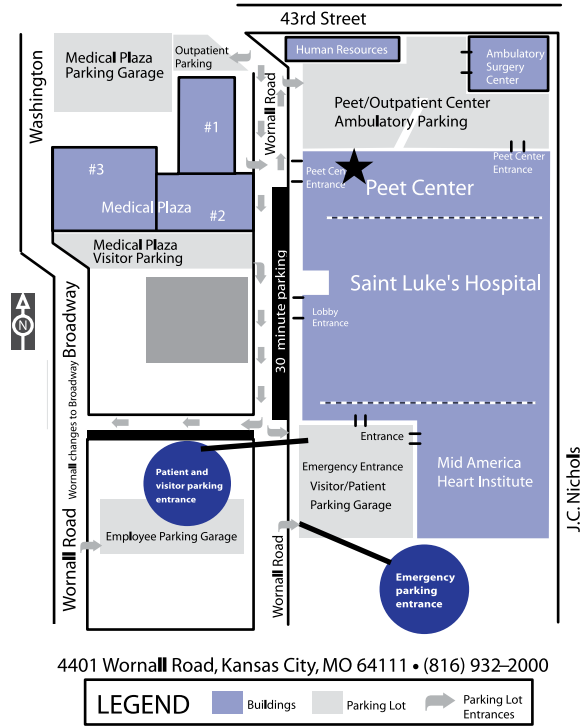
Regular visiting hours are from 7 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. when and if the patient chooses to receive visitors. Exceptions can be made and should be arranged with your nurse. We encourage family members and close friends to spend time with patients during hospitalization. Children are permitted to visit unless they are ill or have been vaccinated recently. This is to protect patients who have impaired immune systems and are at risk for infections.

## Overnight Accommodations

One member of the patient's immediate family is allowed to stay in the room overnight. A cot is available on a first-requested basis.
