It's Free. Donate your baby's cord blood to the Saint Luke's Cord Blood Program. It doesn't cost a thing, and we make it available to anyone, anywhere in the world who needs it.

It's Easy. Right after your baby is born, the umbilical cord is clamped and cut and the blood is collected.

It's Safe & Painless. The procedure is completely painless for you and your baby. It does not interfere with the birthing process. And, if there is any concern about the safety of mother or baby, collection is not made.
