JUNE-DECEMBER

Submit Complete Application - Deadline is **December 31st** of the year prior to desired admission

Submit the following information to the Admissions Office:

- Application
- \$35.00 Application Fee
- Essay
- Three Letters of Recommendation
- Official High School Transcript or GED Score (unless already have a Bachelor's degree)
- Official College Transcripts from All Colleges Attended

Application Review Committee- generally meets twice a month during the academic year

The committee will not review applications until:

- Completion of 29 Hours of General Education Courses Required By Saint Luke's College
- Of that 29 Hours, 2 Required Science Courses Must Be Completed

After the application is reviewed the committee will make one of the following recommendations:

- Invitation for a Faculty Interview
- Decline the Application

Notification of the Committee's decision will be mailed to the applicant's residence.

SEPTEMBER-FEBRUARY

Interview Invitation

After receiving notification to setup an interview, an interview time needs to be confirmed

- Make an Appointment with the Faculty Member to Interview

All interviews must be completed by the end of the first week of February

Obtain a Financial Aid Packet

Financial Aid information and applications are available on our website

- Begin completing Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) between January and the first of March

MARCH

Admissions Selection Committee

One of the following decisions will be made and the outcome will be mailed **by March 1st**

- Acceptance to Saint Luke's College
- Alternate on the Stand-By List (encouraged to proceed with financial aid process)
- Not Accepted to Saint Luke's College

Alternates will be notified if a space in the class becomes available. The stand-by list will continue until the conclusion of the first day of class in August.

Priority Deadline: **March 15th**

March – April (Date to be announced)

APRIL

Foundation Scholarship

Deadline: *April 15th*

- Complete Application and Submit to the Saint Luke's College Financial Aid Office

Entrance Interview and Financial Aid Packaging

April 15th – August 1st

- Schedule a Time to Meet with the Financial Aid Office

JUNE

Summer Classes Begin

Early June (Date to be announced)

- All General Education Courses Must Be Completed
- Mail Final Official Transcripts (if we do not have all credits accounted for already) prior to first day of classes, if unable to have official transcripts before orientation, please send a copy of your grade report to the Admissions Office

JULY

Forms

Due *Mid-July*

- Complete the Health Form and Submit to the Admissions Office
- Verification of Insurance – Send copy to Admissions Office
- Verification of CPR – Send copy to Admissions Office

AUGUST

Paperwork Acquired at the Financial Aid Entrance Interview

Priority Deadline: *August 1st*

- Complete award letter, loan applications, etc and submit to Financial Aid Office

Fall Orientation & Registration

Mid August (Dates to be announced)

- Make Tuition and Fees Payment
- All General Education Courses Must Be Completed
- All Final Official Transcripts Must Be Submitted to the Admissions Office

Fall Classes Begin

Mid-August (Date to be announced)

SEPTEMBER

Scholarship Reception

September (Date to be announced) *For Scholarship Recipients Only*

Excess Financial Aid
