General Information:

Saint Luke's College provides students with an approach to nursing education that blends a well rounded academic background with an in-depth clinical experience. Students may apply for admissions to Saint Luke's College after completing 29 hours of pre-nursing courses and at least 2 of the 4 required natural sciences. Overall grade point average must be a 2.7 or higher. Admissions are selective and fulfillment of the minimum criteria does not ensure acceptance.

Satisfactory completion of the pre-nursing coursework is required for enrollment in Saint Luke's College.
