

**SUBJECT: FOREIGN STUDENT POLICY**

Students for whom English is a second language **must** satisfy following requirements:

1. ♦ Recent TOEFL (Test of English as A Foreign Language) with a minimum score one each of the three sections/subsections of:

i. **23** (twenty-three) internet based testing

Or a

b) **57** (fifty-seven) for paper based testing

Along with a minimum of:

- **4.0** on the written essay

The TOEFL must have been taken within the previous two years prior to the start of the program.

**And:**

- c) A minimum score of **40** (forty) on the TSE (Test of Spoken English) or *SPEAK* prior to the start of the first semester. The TSE is offered by Educational Testing Services (Lees' Summit or Overland Park); the *SPEAK* is offered by the Office of International Programs, KUMC.

**OR**

- ♦ Foreign Student Policy Requirements for admission may be met by meeting the following prior to admission:

a) Successful Completion of a JRCERT accredited United States Radiologic Technology Education Program of at least 24 months.

**And:**

b) Registry from the ARRT (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists)

**ALONG WITH:**

2. Proof of U.S. Citizenship or lawful permanent residency. If the applicant is not a citizen or permanent resident, then s/he must submit copies of her/his passport information pages, I-94 card, U.S. Visa, and/or other documentation that establishes legal non-immigrant status.
3. Course by Course Evaluation of Foreign Transcripts by a U.S. Evaluation Service must be submitted with application.
